OFFER CHOICES

• When you offer choices, you provide communication opportunities for your child, and help them feel in control.



- Offering choices can happen in any DAILY ROUTINE
 - "What do you want to do first brush teeth or put on pajamas?"
 - "How do you want to help get cups or get plates?"
 - o "What's for snack cookies or chips?"
- Offer VISUALS if needed
 - Hold up items to represent the choice, use AAC device to model choices, or write/draw choices
- WAIT for a response
- MODEL a response in the modality your child uses (sign language, iPad, speech, etc.) if your child does not respond on their own.
- START SMALL Offer a choice in just one new activity each day ☺
